

# TECH RIDER

- Stereo, Professional, high quality PA Capable of providing at least 110dB (A) of undistorted full range audio at the mix position. System should be in full working order with suitable coverage & SPL for the size and capacity of the venue/festival stage, and a Graphic EQ should be available for FOH and Monitors to ring out possible feedback.
- A safe and lockable Green Room for our instruments.
- We use our own rack Mixer for wired IEMs, which is COMPLETELY INDEPENDENT from FOH, and we take care of it ourselves. The IEM rack should be situated near the stage box where the vocal mics are connected.
- Synths and Bass play at full range of the frequency spectrum. So, no drastic EQing must be done. IE. Rolling off the Low/High End.
- 3 separate Monitor Mixes only to enhance the Synths and possibly Bass at the front of the stage. Some Kick on Mix 3, please.
- The Synths should be present in the mix, and vocals on top. Han is an experienced Sound Engineer by trade. He can offer support on stage and work together to make this show sound amazing. If the overall volume must be reduced to improve clarity and for the vocals to cut through, we are ok with that.
- All Synth 4 channels are sent to the IEM mixer first, and will be sent to FOH via a 10m XLR loom. The same loom will have 2 other cables with "Y Splits" (provided) for the vocals to be sent INDEPENDENTLY to FOH.
- If a Lighting Engineer is available, hazer and Strobe Lights during choruses/ heavy parts, are welcome. Please favour combinations of magenta at the back, cyan sides, and amber lights at the front. Example below:
